
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
RICE:

Retail prices of all the rice varieties had increased in the range of 3%-7%. The highest retail price increase of 7% was recorded for raw red. Retail price of samba grade I ranged between Rs.98,00-100.00/kg.

VEGETABLES:

Vegetable harvesting of *Yala* 2019 season has been ended up while the harvesting activities as well as prevailed crops were further disturbed by the unfavorable weather situation prevailed in most of the producing areas. As a result, supplies of vegetables were further limited in the market. Therefore, the prices of most of the vegetable varieties have increased during the month. Vegetable prices are expected to increase in coming month too due to off season.





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EXPLANTATORY NOTE

The Food Information Bulletin is a monthly publication containing information relating to producer, wholesale and retail prices of selected food commodities in selected markets in and around Colombo and main markets in the major producing areas. Data on extent, production and imports are also available in the bulletin.

The information is analyzed and presented as, prevailing prices, price ranges, averages and comparison of monthly prices. The changes in prices reported are always in relation to price, which prevailed during the previous month unless otherwise stated.

1. Paddy

Crop Situation

Rainy weather was experienced in all major producing areas throughout the month due to the onset of North East monsoons. Land preparation activities for paddy cultivation in 2019/20 *Maha* season were commenced in all major producing areas with the beginning of the rains. It is expected to that the prospects of the paddy crop in the season will be satisfactory due to the prevailing weather condition and better water availability in irrigation tanks. According to the field information, the land preparation activities of paddy crop were in progress in most of the major producing areas. Crop establishment activities also progressed in major producing areas like Eastern province, Udawalawe and Kurunegala districts. The peak crop establishment activities can be expected during the next month.

Producer Prices

An increasing trend of prices began from the latter part of the August continue for all paddy varieties throughout this month in most of the major producing areas due to the limited supply as a result of the end of the harvesting of paddy crop in 2019 *Yala* season. Prices have increased mainly due to the competitive buying of newly harvested paddy by the rice millers. The monthly average prices of long grain white paddy have increased by less than 10% in all considered major producing areas with the highest increase from Anuradhapura. The prices of short grain have increased by 2% - 10% in all major producing areas. The prices of short grain and long grain white were ranged between Rs.46.00-51.50/Kg and Rs.47.00-52.70/Kg in major producing areas. It is observed that the prices of long grain white were higher than the prices of short grain paddy in most of the major producing areas during this season. The monthly average prices of long grain

red paddy ranged between Rs.46.00-52.00/Kg in producing areas in Southern Province. According to the field information, it is expected to that the increasing trend of prices will be continued during the next month too.

Compared to the same period of last year, the prices of long grain white paddy have increased by 20% - 31% in major producing areas. Meanwhile the prices of short grain white paddy have increased by less than 4% in Polonnaruwa and Kalawewa while the prices have declined by less than 3% in Anuradhapura and Kurunegala. It was noted that the prices of long grain red have increased by 40% in Embilipitiya and Hambanthota.

Rice Prices Demand/Supply Situation

Wholesale Prices

A decreasing trend of supplies was observed for all the rice verities during the month. Hence, the wholesale prices of all the rice varieties had increased with the highest price increase of 8% for raw red. Wholesale price of raw red ranged between Rs.78.00-88.00. Wholesale prices of samba grade I and grade II ranged between Rs.95.00-100.00/kg and Rs.88.00-92.00/kg respectively. The average price of samba had increased by 5% compared to the previous month.

Furthermore, the wholesale price of nadu grade I and II had increased by 5% and 4% respectively. According to the market information, further price increase for most of the rice varieties could be expected in next month too.

Compared to the same period of last year, wholesale prices most of the rice varieties had increased with the highest price increase of 21% for raw red.

According to the Department of Customs of Sri Lanka, a quantity of 2,771mt of rice had been imported in October 2019. The total expenditure on importing rice in October was Rs.271.1mn.

Retail Prices

In line with the wholesale prices, retail prices of all the varieties of rice had increased in the range of 3%-7%. The highest price increase of 7% was recorded for raw red. Further, the retail prices of nadu and raw white increased by 5% compared to the previous month. Retail Price of samba grade I and II ranged between Rs.98.00-110.00/kg and Rs.90.00-95.00/kg respectively. According to the market information. Further price increase could be expected for most of the rice varieties in next month too.

Compare to the same period of last year, retail prices of most of the rice varieties had increased with the highest price increase of 13% for raw red significant decrease of supplies of raw red was observed from both wholesale and retail markets.

Compared to the previous year. Meanwhile the retail prices of samba grade I and grade II had decreased by 14% and 15% respectively. Compared to the previous month.

2. Other Field Crops

2.1 Chilli

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

Supply of green chilli from major producing areas has dropped with the end of harvesting in this *Yala* season. Hence, both wholesale and retail prices of green chilli have increased by about Rs.68.00/kg and Rs.82.00/kg respectively. Average wholesale and retail prices of green chilli were Rs.237.50/kg and Rs.410.01/kg respectively and both prices have increased by about 149% and 60% respectively, compared to the same period of last year, prices of green chilli are expected to be increasing in coming months.

Imported quantity of dried chilli was 4,053 Mt and it was mainly imported from India during this month. It was a decrease of 1,033 Mt compared to that of last month. The average CIF price was Rs.359.50/kg and it has increased by Rs.30.73/kg compared to the previous month. Both wholesale and retail prices of imported dried chilli have increased by about Rs.41.00/kg and Rs.51.00/kg respectively. Compared to the same period of last year, wholesale and retail prices of imported dried chilli have increased by about 76% and 54% respectively.

2.2 Red Onion and Big Onion

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

The market supply of big onion consisted of both imported and local big onion varieties during this month. Though October is the peak-harvesting month of local big onion, limited stock has reached to the market as the low production during this season. With the limited stocks position, both wholesale and retail prices of local big onion have increased by about Rs.96.00/kg and Rs.55.00/kg respectively.

A quantity of 20,928 Mt of big onion was imported in October 2019 and this quantity was higher than the previous month. Around 37% of big onion was imported from by about 15,757Mt Pakistan, 27% from Egypt, 14% from India, 8% from Netherland, 6% from China, 4% from Turkey and rest of the 4% from Arab and Iran The imported quantity from India has come down significantly as the Indian government has banned the export due to unfavourable weather situation prevailed in India. Both wholesale and retail prices of imported big onion have increased by about Rs.24.00/kg and Rs.8.00/kg respectively due to limited stock position. Compared to the same period of last year, wholesale price and retail price of imported big onion have increased by about 236% and 123% respectively.

The supply of both sinnan and vedalan red onion varieties had decreased from Puttalam and Jaffna districts as it was the latter part of the harvesting season. Hence, wholesale prices of both sinnan and vedalan have increased by about Rs.98.00/kg and Rs.135.00/kg respectively. Retail price of vedalan has also increased by Rs.134.00/kg while sinnan varieties were not available at most of retail markets. Red onion stocks were not imported during this month and wholesale price has increased by about Rs.26.00/kg. Imported red onion stocks were not available at the retail markets.

2.3 Potato

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

Maha cultivation of potatoes has been commenced in major potato growing districts and yala harvesting of potato is being taken place with the availability of ample stocks in the market. A quantity of 7,550 mt of potato had been imported in October which was 2,940 mt lower than that was imported during the previous month. Imported stocks were received mainly from Pakistan (63%) and China (32%) in October. Compared to October, 2018 (6,329 mt), the imports were high during this month. Average CIF price was Rs.52.00/kg in October.

With regard to local potato, sufficient stocks of the *yala* harvest were available in the market. On average, the producer prices of Nuwara Eliya and Welimada potatoes were Rs.92.00/kg and Rs.97.00/kg in October. Wholesale prices of Nuwara Eliya and Welimada potatoes have decreased by 15% and 21% respectively. Also, the retail prices of Nuwara Eliya and Welimada potatoes have decreased by 4% and 3% respectively. Meanwhile, the wholesale price of imported potato has decreased by 6% while the retail price has not changed significantly. During the month, the wholesale prices of Welimada, Nuwara Eliya and imported potatoes ranged between Rs.80.00-120.00/kg, Rs.100.00-140.00/kg and Rs.85.00-110.00/kg respectively. Compared to the same period of last year, the current retail prices of Welimada (30%), Nuwara Eliya (23%) and imported (20%) potatoes have increased. As the peak harvesting season for potato will be over in November, the prices of local potatoes are expected to increase in coming months.

2.4 Green gram and Cowpea

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

The wholesale price of green gram ranged between Rs.230/kg and Rs.255/kg with an average of Rs.244/kg in October 2019. The average price has not significantly changed compared to the previous month. Similarly, compared to the same period of last year, the wholesale price has been increased by 21%. In the meantime, the retail price of green gram ranged between Rs.260/kg and Rs.300/kg with an average of Rs.282/kg. Compared to the previous month, the retail price has not significantly changed. However, compared to the same period of last year, the retail price for this month has been increased to around 15% (Table 2.4.2).

Average wholesale prices of white and red cowpea were recorded as Rs.242/kg and Rs.215/kg respectively in October 2019. The wholesale price of white cowpea ranged between Rs.225/kg

and Rs.250/kg, while that of red cowpea ranged between Rs.205/kg and Rs.250/kg. Compared to the previous month, the wholesale price of white cowpea has been increased by 8% and red cowpea has been decreased by around 6%. Compared to the same period of last year, the wholesale price of white cowpea has been increased by 17% and red cowpea has increased by 17% (Table 2.4.2).

The average retail prices of white and red cowpea were recorded as Rs.290/kg and Rs.294/kg respectively. The retail price of white cowpea ranged between Rs.260/kg and Rs.320/kg, and that of red cowpea also ranged between Rs.260/kg and Rs.320/kg. Compared to the previous month, white cowpea has been increased by 3% while red cowpea has decreased around 2%. Compared to the same period of last year, the retail price of white cowpea has been increased by 5% and red cowpea has been increased around 10% (Table 2.4.2).

A total of 1,163 Mt of green gram has been imported during this month, and it has increased around 5% compared to the green gram quantity imported in the previous month. The average CIF price of green gram was Rs.167.34/kg which was increased about 1% compared with the previous month. The total expenditure of the importation of green gram was recorded as Rs.194.53 million which has increased by 6% of the total value spent on green gram importation compared to the previous month. Green gram has been imported from several counties which are Argentina (46%), Australia (33%) and Myanmar (21%).

According to table 2.4.4, a total of 1,371 Mt of white cowpea has been imported during this month. The imported quantity of cowpea has been increased by 72% compared to imported quantity of September 2019. The average CIF price of white cowpea was recorded as Rs.130/kg. The total expenditure on cowpea imports has been increased by 77% compared to the previous month. The total value of the cowpea imports was noted as approximately Rs.178.03 million. The highest quantity of cowpea was imported from Madagascar (67%), India (13%), Myanmar (13%) and Brazil (7%).

2.5 Red dhal

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

The wholesale price of red dhal ranged between Rs.105/kg and Rs.110/kg with an average of Rs.107/kg, and the retail price ranged between Rs.120/kg and Rs.140.00/kg with an average of Rs.128/kg. Moreover, the difference between the two prices is Rs.21/kg during this month. The both wholesale price and the retail price have not significantly changed compared with the previous month. Compared to the same period of last year, wholesale price has been increased around 4% while the retail price has increased by 2%.

Total quantity was of the whole type red dhal. Of The whole type of red dhal, 64% from Australia, 35% from Canada and 1% from India have been imported. The total value of the whole type of red dhal imports was Rs. 1429 million.

3. Vegetables

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

Vegetable harvesting of *Yala* 2019 season has been ended up during the month of October while the harvesting activities were further disturbed by the unfavorable weather situation prevailed in most of the producing areas. Rainy weather condition continued from last couple of months has also damaged prevailed crops in most of the vegetable producing areas. As a result, supplies of vegetables were further limited in the market during the month. Therefore, the prices of most of the vegetable varieties have increased during the month. With regard to up-country vegetables, the wholesale price of all the vegetable varieties except for beans have increased by 9%-82% and the highest price increase was recorded for carrot. Among low-country vegetables, wholesale prices of most of the varieties have increased by 12%-127% recording the highest for drumstick and the lowest for long beans.

Compared to the same period of last year, wholesale prices of most of the vegetable varieties had increased by 6%-94%.

The retail prices of most of vegetable varieties have increased during the month. The prices of all the up-country vegetables except for beans have increased by 8%-37%. Among up-country vegetables, the highest retail price of Rs.320.00/kg was recorded for carrot while the lowest price of Rs. 90.00/kg was noted for leeks. With regard to low-country vegetables, the prices of most of the varieties have increased by 3%-74%. Among low-country vegetables, the highest price was recorded as Rs.400.00/kg for capsicum and drumstick while the lowest price (Rs.60.00) was observed for cucumber.

Compared to the same period of last year, the prices of up-country vegetables had increased by 9%-28% while that of low-country vegetables had increased by 1%-55%.

4. Fruits

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

Compared to the prices in September, 2019, wholesale prices of most of the fruit varieties had decreased in October, 2019. Accordingly, banana varieties, Seeni, Kolikuttu and Ambul had recorded price decreases in the range of 1%-14% and had recorded price ranges of Rs.60.00-90.00/kg, Rs.150.00-180.00/kg and Rs.50.00-80.00/kg for Seeni, Kolikuttu and Ambul respectively. At the same time, price decreases were noted for pineapple too and prices had decreased by 8% for small and by 10% for medium and large sized fruits. The monthly average wholesale prices of small, medium and large sized fruits were Rs.118.00/fruit, Rs.154.00/fruit and Rs.193.00/fruit respectively and the price ranged between Rs.80.00-240.00/fruit. Prices of all the mango varieties had also decreased and had recorded price decreases of 4%, 21%, 34% and 55% for varieties, Kohu, Vilad, Betti and Karthakolomban respectively. Price of papaw had decreased by 39% and the monthly average wholesale price was Rs.42.00/kg and the price ranged between Rs.30.00-60.00/kg. In addition, prices of passion fruit, grapes (imported), slime apple and wood apple had decreased by 19%, 16%, 14% and 8% respectively (Table 4.1).

However, prices of orange and avocado had increased by 7% and 9% respectively. Further, though the prices of banana varieties, Seeni, Kolikuttu and Ambul had decreased, prices of banana varieties, Ambun and Anamalu had increased by 2% and 3% respectively and their prices ranged between Rs.14.00-18.00/fruit and Rs.11.00-14.00/fruit respectively (Table 4.1).

Compared to the same period of 2018, wholesale prices of most of the fruit varieties had decreased and the highest price decrease of 40% was noted for both papaw and mango variety, Betti (Table 4.1).

According to the data in previous years, prices of fruit varieties, banana, papaw, pineapple, mango and slime apple are expected to be decreased in the coming month, November while, prices of passion fruit, orange, avocado and wood apple are expected to be increased.

Prices of all the fruit varieties except avocado had decreased at the retail level in the month of October compared to September. Accordingly, prices of all the banana varieties had decreased in the range of 1%-15% and price ranges were noted as Rs.80.00-140.00/kg, Rs.90.00-150.00/kg and Rs.180.00-260.00/kg for Ambul, Seeni and Kolikuttu respectively. Further, prices of Anamalu and Ambun ranged between Rs.15.00-20.00/fruit and Rs.20.00-25.00/fruit respectively. Prices of small, medium and large sized pineapple had decreased by 4%, 1% and 3% respectively and the monthly average retail prices of small, medium and large sized fruits were Rs.146.00/fruit, Rs.201.00/fruit and Rs.260.00/fruit respectively and the price ranged between Rs.100.00-300.00/fruit. Prices of mango varieties, Karthakolomban and Vilad had also decreased by 45% and 19% respectively and price of a fruit was noted as Rs.40.00-120.00 for Karthakolomban and Rs.25.00-60.00 for Vilad. Price of papaw had decreased by 23% and the price ranged between Rs.80.00-120.00/kg. In addition, prices of slime apple and passion fruit had decreased by 18% and

15% respectively. Further, price decreases of 5%, 4% and 1% were noted for grapes (imported), wood apple and orange respectively (Table 4.2).

However, as stated earlier, price of avocado had increased by 18% and the price ranged between Rs.40.00-120.00/fruit (Table 4.2).

Compared to the same period of 2018, retail prices of most of the fruit varieties had also decreased with the highest price decrease of 44% noted for mango variety, Karthakolomban (Table 4.2).

With reference to the producer prices, producers had received decreased prices for papaw and banana varieties, Kolikuttu and Ambul compared to September. Accordingly, prices had decreased by 11% for Kolikuttu, 23% for papaw and by 29% for Ambul. Producer prices for Ambul, Kolikuttu and papaw during the month ranged between Rs.27.00-65.00/kg, Rs.110.00-147.00/kg and Rs.22.00-33.00/kg respectively. At the same time, compared to October, 2018, producer prices had increased only for Kolikuttu by 8% and it was a price decrease for both papaw and Ambul by 21% and 6% respectively (Table 4.3).

Exports/Imports of Fruits

According to the Sri Lanka Customs, Sri Lanka had exported 1,606mt of fresh fruits in October, 2019 to the value of Rs. 217mn. Of the exported quantity, 92% were papaw, 4% were fresh pineapple, 3% were fresh mangoes and 1% was fresh avocados. In addition, a small quantity (0.1mt) of fresh oranges was also exported. In the month of September, 2019, the quantity exported was 1,320mt. Therefore, compared to last month, the exported quantity had increased by 22% (Table 4.4).

With reference to imports, Sri Lanka had imported 4,536mt of fresh fruits during the month and the value was Rs. 786mn. Of the imported quantity, 69% were apple, 18% were oranges and 14% were grapes. The main importing countries of apple were China, South Africa, France and the United States. Oranges had been imported from South Africa and Australia. China, Italy and the United States were the importing countries of Grapes. In the month of September, 2019, the quantity imported was 3,944mt. Therefore, compared to last month, the imported quantity had increased by 15% (Table 4.5).

5. Fish, Dried Fish, Eggs and Meat

Fish

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

Supplies of all the selected fresh fish types have increased during the month. Therefore, the wholesale prices of all the fresh fish types have decreased in the range of 6%-25%. The highest price decrease was recorded for kelawalla due to increase the supplies from Beruwala, Galle and Matara. Supplies of paraw had been increased from most of the major supplying areas. Therefore, the wholesale price of paraw has decreased by 24%. Stocks of salaya had been increased mainly from Kalpitiya, Mannar and Trincomalee and the price has decreased by 24%. Increased supplies were observed for Hurulla too. Hence, wholesale price has decreased by 19%. Thora had been mainly supplied from Northern Province and the price has decreased by 22%. The wholesale price of Thalapath has decreased by 13% as a result of increase the supplies from Negambo, Beruwala, Galle and Matara. The wholesale price of shrimp (small) also has decreased by 9% due to increase the supplies from Jaffna.

Compared to the same period of last year, the wholesale prices of all the fresh fish types except for Thora had increased in the range of 18%-71%.

The retail prices of all the fresh fish types have decreased in the range of 2%-21% recording the highest for Salaya and the lowest for Shrimp (small). The highest price of Rs.1,800.00/kg was recorded for Thora, while the lowest price of Rs.180.00/kg was observed for Salaya.

Compared to the same period of last year, retail prices of all the fresh fish types expect for thora and mora had increased by 12%-70%.

Dried Fish

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

Supplies of both local as well as imported dried fish types have increased to the market during the month. With reference to the local dried fish types, Thora and Balaya had received from Negambo and Beruwala, while Anguluwa received from Jaffna. The supplies of Salaya has increased from Trincomalee and Jaffna, while Sprats increased from Mullaitivu, Mannar and Negambo. With regard to imported dried fish, Anguluwa supplied from Pakistan and Oman, thora from Maldives and Indonesia, Sprats from Dubai and Balaya from Pakistan. Therefore, sufficient stocks were available in most of the markets. The wholesale prices of all the dried fish types except for imported Maduwa have decreased in the range of 1%-17% and the highest price decrease was recorded for both imported and local Balaya.

Compared to the same period of last year, wholesale prices of all the dried fish types had increased in the range of 2%-42%.

In line with the wholesale prices, the retail prices of most of the dried fish types have decreased in the range of 1%-4%. The highest price decrease was recorded for Balaya (4%), imported Sprats (3%) and salaya (2%).

Compared to the same period of last year, retail prices of most of the dried fish types had increased in the range of 1%-13%.

The retail price of brown egg ranged between Rs.20.00-23.00/egg, followed by white egg as Rs.19.00-22.00/egg. 6. Wheat grain, Wheat flour and Sugar

Wheat grain and Wheat flour

A total quantity of 188,638mt. worth of 8,825mn. wheat grain had been imported during the month of October. Compared to the previous month, quantity of this month has increased and it was 41,321mt. in terms of quantity. Wheat grain for the month of October had been mainly imported from United States (45%) and the CIF price was Rs.47.00/kg. Second and third highest wheat grain quantities were imported from Canada (44,400mt.) and Russia (27,500mt.) respectively. In addition, wheat grain had been imported from Romania (13%) and Australia (4%). Few quantities were also imported from India and Ukraine as well. The CIF price of wheat grain ranged between Rs.39.00-69.00/kg and the average CIF price was recorded as Rs.47.00/kg.

Compared to the previous month, average CIF price for wheat grain has decreased by Rs.2.00/kg during the month.

A total quantity of 564mt. of wheat flour worth of 41mn. had been imported during the month of October. Compared to the previous month, quantity of this month has decreased by more than twice in terms of quantity. Wheat flour for the month of October had been mainly imported from India (46%) and the CIF price was Rs.79.00/kg. Wheat flour has also imported from Pakistan (8%). Few quantities were also imported from Italy as well. The CIF price of wheat flour ranged between Rs.62.00-79.00/kg and the average CIF price was recorded as Rs.73.00/kg (Based on the prices of two major importing countries). Compared to the previous month, average CIF price for wheat flour has increased only by Rs.1.00/kg during the month.

Meanwhile, the local retail price of wheat flour ranged between Rs.84.00-100.00/kg and the average price was Rs.93.00/kg. Compared to the previous month, the average retail price of wheat flour has decreased only by Rs.1.00/kg during the month. Further, compared to the same period of last year, retail price of wheat flour has decreased by 2%.

Sugar

A total quantity of 48,249mt. worth of 3,093mn. of sugar had been imported to the country during the month of October. Compared to the previous month, quantity of this month has further increased and it was 3,381mt. in terms of quantity. Sugar for the month of October had been mainly imported from India (47%) and its' CIF price was Rs.63.00/kg. The second highest sugar quantity was imported from Thailand (45%). Further, sugar stocks were imported from Pakistan (7%), United Arab Emirates (1%) and Korea (1%) as well. In addition, few quantities were also imported from Malaysia as well. The CIF prices ranged between Rs.62.00-90.00/kg and the average CIF price was reported as Rs.64.00/kg. Compared to the previous month, average CIF price for sugar has decreased only by Rs.1.00/kg during the month. According to the World Food and Agriculture Organization, sugar price index averaged to 178 points in October 2019, up by nearly 6% from September 2019. The sharp rebound in international sugar prices in October was mainly underpinned by expectation of much tighter supply prospects in 2019/20.

Referring to the local retail price of sugar for the month of October, price ranged between Rs.99.00-110.00/kg and the average retail price was Rs.107.00/kg. Compared to the previous month the average retail price of sugar remained unchanged during the month. Further, compared to the same period of last year, average retail price of sugar has decreased by 3%.
