
Highlights

Rice

Producer prices for all paddy varieties have risen across major producing areas compared to the previous month, largely attributed to the planting season. The most significant wholesale price increase of 5% was observed for Keeri Samba, driven by a persistent decline in supply. This shortage has resulted in Keeri Samba being available at only a few retail outlets.

Vegetables

Prices for most vegetables have increased due to a decrease in supply, largely resulting from heavy rains that have disrupted both cultivation and harvesting in many major producing areas. Retail prices have surged by 9% to 70%, with the highest increase reported for drumsticks. Beans are now priced at a high of Rs.568.00/kg. Given the current conditions, it is anticipated that vegetable prices will rise even further in the upcoming month.

1. Paddy/Rice

Producer Prices

Producer prices for all paddy varieties have increased across major producing areas compared to the previous month, largely due to the planting season. Short grain paddy prices rose by 3-9% across all regions, with the highest increase observed in Ampara, ranging from Rs.115.00-130.00/kg.

For long grain white paddy, prices ranged between Rs.109.00-130.00/kg in major producing areas, with average prices rising by 4-9% from the previous month, again led by a notable increase in Ampara. The largest price hike was observed in long grain red paddy, with a 7-10% increase compared to the previous month. Prices for long grain red ranged from Rs.110.00-112.00/kg in Hambantota, Matara, and Embilipitiya. Additionally, the average producer price for keeri samba increased by approximately 5% in all major producing areas, with prices ranging from Rs.140.00-157.00/kg.

Compared to the same period last year, producer prices for short grain, long grain white, and keeri samba have risen across all regions, with keeri samba showing the highest increase of 27-40%. In contrast, producer prices for long grain red have declined by 10-12% across all producing areas.

Rice Prices Demand/Supply Situation

Wholesale Prices

Wholesale prices for all rice varieties have increased by 2-5% compared to the previous month. The highest increase, at 5%, was observed for Keeri Samba, driven by a continued decline in supply. Prices for Keeri Samba ranged from Rs.300.00-315.00/kg, marking an all-time high. Wholesale prices for Samba Grade I and Grade II ranged from Rs.225.00-235.00/kg and Rs.220.00-226.00/kg, respectively, with average prices rising by 2-3%. Additionally, prices for raw red and raw white rice increased by 4%, attributed to the off-season.

Compared to the same period last year, wholesale prices for all rice varieties, except raw red, increased by 0.5-31%, with Keeri Samba showing the largest increase at 31%. Conversely, the wholesale price of raw red declined by 11% year-on-year.

Retail Prices

Retail prices for all local rice varieties rose by under 2% compared to the previous month, consistent with the trend in wholesale prices. The shortage of Keeri Samba continued, with it available at only a limited number of retail outlets. Additionally, the average retail prices for Samba Grade 1, Keeri Samba, and Nadu Grade 1 exceeded the government-regulated maximum retail price (MRP). Year-on-year, retail prices for most rice varieties increased by 1-25%, with Keeri Samba experiencing

the highest rise. Conversely, the retail price of raw red rice decreased by Rs.24.00/kg compared to the same period last year.

2. Other Field Crops

2.1 Chilli

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

The supply of green chili from major producing areas decreased this month, resulting in an upward trend in producer prices during the last week. Consequently, both wholesale and retail prices of green chili rose by approximately Rs.49.00/kg and Rs.65.00/kg, respectively. The average wholesale and retail prices were Rs.414.00/kg and Rs.702.00/kg, respectively. Prices are expected to continue increasing in the coming months as the harvesting season concludes. Compared to the same period last year, wholesale and retail prices of green chili have surged by around 154% and 89%, respectively.

In November 2023, 3,321 metric tons of dried chili were imported, a decrease of 1,330 metric tons from the previous month. The average CIF price was Rs.774.67/kg, a drop of Rs.8.13/kg compared to the prior month. However, the wholesale price of imported dried chili remained stable, while the retail price decreased by about Rs.4.00/kg. Wholesale prices ranged from Rs.990.00-1,100.00/kg, and retail prices ranged from Rs.1,100.00-1,500.00/kg. Compared to the same period last year,

wholesale and retail prices of imported dried chili have decreased by approximately 34% and 28%, respectively.

2.2 Red Onion and Big Onion

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

This month, the market supply of big onions relied entirely on imports, with 18,604 metric tons brought in during November 2023—a reduction of 1,917 metric tons compared to the previous month. The average CIF price increased to Rs.135.69/kg, up by Rs.30.84/kg from the prior month. Consequently, wholesale and retail prices of imported big onions rose by approximately Rs.11.00/kg and Rs.39.00/kg, respectively, with average wholesale and retail prices recorded at Rs.201.47/kg and Rs.298.16/kg. Year-on-year, the wholesale price of imported big onions dropped by about 11%, while the retail price increased by 6%.

The supply of local red onions from major producing areas also declined this month, driving up the wholesale and retail prices of *vedalan* by approximately Rs.25.00/kg and Rs.108.00/kg, respectively. *Sinnan* stocks were largely unavailable in most markets, with *vedalan* retail prices ranging between Rs.400.00-720.00/kg.

Additionally, 1,025 metric tons of red onions were imported from India this month, a significant increase of 983 metric tons over the previous month. The average CIF price rose to Rs.235.61/kg, up by Rs.56.66/kg from the prior month. Meanwhile, the wholesale price of imported red onions decreased by around Rs.41.00/kg. Compared to the same period last year, retail prices for *vedalan* and imported red onions declined by approximately 15% and 18%, respectively.

2.3 Potato

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

This month, both local and imported potato stocks were available in the market. The average producer prices for Welimada and Nuwara Eliya potatoes were Rs.204.00/kg and Rs.227.00/kg, respectively, in November. Compared to the previous month, wholesale prices rose by 16% for Nuwara Eliya potatoes, 21% for Welimada potatoes, and 7% for imported potatoes.

Retail prices ranged from Rs.280.00-380.00/kg for Welimada potatoes, Rs.350.00-440.00/kg for Nuwara Eliya potatoes, and Rs.150.00-260.00/kg for imported potatoes. Wholesale prices across all potato varieties, including imported stocks, ranged between Rs.210.00-300.00/kg during the month.

2.4 Green gram and Cowpea

Prices and Supply/ Demand Situation

In November 2023, the wholesale price of green gram ranged from Rs.700.00/kg to Rs.800.00/kg, with an average of Rs.743.00/kg, marking a slight decrease compared to October 2023. However, year-on-year, the wholesale price has risen by 28%. The average retail price for green gram was Rs.1,104.00/kg, with a range of Rs.900.00-1,000.00/kg, reflecting a 10% decrease compared to the same period last year.

For cowpea, the average wholesale prices in November 2023 were Rs.951.00/kg for white cowpea and Rs.975.00/kg for red cowpea, with prices ranging between Rs.940.00-1,000.00/kg. Compared to October 2023, the wholesale price of white cowpea increased by 2%, and red cowpea by 5%, showing a slight rise over the previous year.

2.5 Red dhal

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

The wholesale price of red dhal in November 2023 ranged from Rs.285.00/kg to Rs.300.00/kg, with an average price of Rs.295.00/kg. This represents a 17% decrease compared to the same period last year, although monthly prices remained stable compared to October 2023. The retail price for red dhal was recorded at Rs.339.00/kg, reflecting a 12% reduction from the same period last year.

3. Vegetables

Crop Situation

The cultivation of Maha 2023/2024 has commenced, with both up-country and low-country vegetable planting currently in progress. The targeted area for up-country vegetables this season is 18,388 hectares, aiming for a production of 252,657 metric tons. For low-country vegetables, the expected cultivation area is 22,664 hectares, with a projected production of 258,462 metric tons. However, prolonged rains are posing challenges for crop cultivation, which is likely to negatively impact vegetable production this season.

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

Prices for all vegetables have risen due to decreased supply. The wholesale prices of up-country vegetables have increased by 36% to 105%, with the highest price increase observed for cabbage at 105%. Beans recorded the highest price at Rs.395.00/kg, while radish had the lowest price at Rs.149.00/kg.

In the case of low-country vegetables, wholesale prices increased by 9% to 114%, with the most significant rise noted for drumsticks. Capsicum reached the highest price at Rs.542.00/kg, while

pumpkin had the lowest price at Rs.83.00/kg. Due to limited supply from producing areas, the average price of lime reached Rs.1,548.00/kg, reflecting a 10% increase.

When comparing prices to the same period last year, wholesale prices for most up-country vegetables have decreased by 11% to 56%. However, lime prices have seen a dramatic increase of 403% compared to last year's prices.

In line with the wholesale price trends, retail prices for all vegetable varieties have increased by 9% to 70%. Among up-country vegetables, the highest price increase was reported for cabbage at 43%. In the low-country category, drumsticks saw the most significant rise, with a 70% increase. Beans reached the highest retail price at Rs.568.00/kg, while pumpkin had the lowest at Rs.174.00/kg.

Additionally, the price of green chili rose by 10%, and lime prices increased by 8%. Compared to the same period last year, retail prices for most up-country vegetable varieties have decreased by 13% to 34%.

4. Fruits

Prices and Supply/Demand Situation

In November, wholesale prices for most fruit varieties have risen. For bananas, prices for all varieties except kolikuttu have increased, with the highest price rise of 15% noted for ambul bananas, followed by seeni and anamalu, which saw increases of 3%. During the month, wholesale prices ranged as follows: Rs.400.00-500.00/kg for kolikuttu, Rs.110.00-200.00/kg for ambul, Rs.120.00-170.00/kg for seeni, Rs.28.00-34.00 per fruit for ambun, and Rs.23.00-30.00 per fruit for anamalu.

Conversely, prices for all sizes of pineapple have decreased by 13% to 15% due to the ongoing harvesting season in the Gampaha district. The average wholesale prices were Rs.523.00 per fruit for large, Rs.424.00 for medium, and Rs.315.00 for small sizes.

With a significant influx of mango stocks into the market, wholesale prices for all types of mangoes have dropped by 20% to 60%, with the most substantial decrease seen for karthakolomban.

Among other fruit varieties, the highest price increase of 56% was reported for oranges due to off-season conditions. Prices for avocado, wood apple, and slime apple increased by 34%, 9%, and 6%, respectively. Meanwhile, prices for passion fruit and imported grapes decreased by 44% and 11%, respectively.

Compared to the same period last year, current wholesale prices for all fruit varieties have risen, with the most notable increase of 107% observed for slime apples.

In November, retail prices for most fruit varieties have risen, reflecting trends observed in the wholesale market. Specifically, prices for ambul, seeni, ambun, and anamalu bananas increased by 1% to 4%. During the month, retail prices ranged from Rs.500.00 to Rs.700.00/kg for kolikuttu bananas and Rs.160.00 to Rs.280.00/kg for ambul bananas in Colombo and suburban markets.

Additionally, the prices of oranges (37%), avocados (20%), papaw (19%), and wood apples (13%) have risen due to low stock levels. In contrast, prices for all sizes of pineapples have decreased by 10% to 12%, with retail prices ranging from Rs.350.00 to Rs.700.00 per fruit in Colombo's suburban markets.

Compared to the same period last year, current retail prices for all fruit varieties have increased, with the most significant rise of 64% reported for ambun bananas.

Exports/Imports of Fruits

According to Sri Lanka Customs, the country exported 1,796 metric tons (mt) of fresh fruits in November 2023, valued at Rs.254 million. Notably, 96% of the exported fresh fruits were papaw, while 3% comprised fresh mangoes, avocados, and mangosteen. In November 2022, the quantity exported was 1,235 mt, indicating an increase in exports compared to the previous year (see Table 4.3).

On the import side, Sri Lanka imported 925 mt of fresh fruits during the same month, amounting to Rs.384 million. Apples were the most imported fruit, totaling 612 mt, followed by grapes at 214 mt. Compared to November 2022, when 649 mt were imported, this year's imported quantity represents a 43% increase (see Table 4.4).
